We thank you for your confirmation to Sahyadri Industries Limited (the "Company") that you meet the "independence" criteria as envisaged in Section 149(6) of the Companies Act, 2013 ("2013 Act") [and Clause 49 of the Listing Agreement as amended vide circular issued by Securities and Exchange Board of India ref no. CIR/CFD/POLICY CELL/2/2014 dated April 17, 2014 and effective from October 1, 2014] and also for your consenting to hold office as a director of the Company. Pursuant to your confirmation, we are pleased to confirm that the shareholders have approved your appointment as an Independent Director on the Board of the Company

1. Appointment

Your appointment will be for an initial term up to 07th August 2015 and shall take effect from 08th August 2014, unless terminated earlier or extended, as per the provisions of this letter or applicable laws ("Term"). As an Independent Director you will not be liable to retire by rotation. Re-appointment at the end of the Term shall be based on the recommendation of the Nominations Committee and subject to the approval of the Board and the shareholders. Your re-appointment would be considered by the Board based on the outcome of the performance evaluation process and you continuing to meet the independence criteria.

As per the decision of the Board, you will be a Chairman / member of the one or more of the following Committees:

The Board may reconstitute the composition of any/all Committees, from time to time, and any such change shall be promptly communicated to you. In such an event you may also be required to serve on other Committees of the Board.

2. Roles, Duties and Responsibilities

- A) As member of the Board you along with the other Directors will be collectively responsible for meeting the objectives of the Board which include:
- Requirements under the Companies Act, 2013,
- "Responsibilities of the Board" as outlined in the Corporate Governance requirements as prescribed by Stock Exchanges under Clause 49 of the Listing Agreement,
- Accountability under the Director's Responsibility Statement,
- Overseeing the maintenance of high standards of moral values and ethical conduct of business.
- Protecting and enhancing the Company's brands and image.
- B) You shall abide by the 'Code For Independent Directors' as outlined in Schedule IV to section 149(8) of the 2013 Act, and duties of directors as provided in the 2013 Act

(including Section 166) and in Clause 49 of the Listing Agreement.

C) You will also be responsible for providing guidance in the area of your expertise.

3. Time Commitment

Considering the nature of the role of a director, it is difficult for a company to lay down specific parameters on time commitment. You agree to devote such time as is prudent and necessary or the proper performance of your role, duties and responsibilities as an Independent Director.

4. Remuneration

As an Independent Director you shall be paid sitting fees for attending the meetings of the Board and the Committees of which you are a member.

The present sitting fees payable to you are as follows:

Board: Rs.2000/meeting

Further, the Company may pay or reimburse to you such fair and reasonable expenditure, as may have been incurred by you while performing your role as an Independent Director of the Company. This could include reimbursement of expenditure incurred by you for attending Board/ Committee meetings, Annual General Meetings, Extraordinary General Meetings, court convened meetings, meetings with shareholders/ creditors/ management, site visits etc.

5. Insurance

The Company may take an appropriate Directors' and Officers' Liability Insurance policy and pay the premiums for the same.

6. Code of Conduct

As a Director of the Company, you agree to comply with the Code of Conduct for Directors. The Code has been circulated, accepted and displayed on the Company's website.

Unless specifically authorised by the Company, you shall not disclose company and business information to public constituencies such as the media, the financial community, employees, shareholders, agents, franchises, dealers, distributors and importers. Your obligation of confidentiality shall survive termination or cessation of your directorship with the Company. Additionally, you shall not participate in any business activity which might impede the application of your independent judgment in the best interest of the Company.

7. Induction and Development

The Company shall, if required, conduct formal induction program for its Independent Directors which may include any or all of the following:

- Board roles and responsibilities, whilst seeking to build working relationship among the Board members,
- Company's vision, strategic direction, core values, ethics and corporate governance practices,

- Familiarization with financial matters, management team and business operations.
- Meetings with stakeholders, visits to business locations and meetings with senior and middle management.

The Company shall, as may be required, support Directors to continually update their skills and knowledge and improve their familiarity with the company and its business. The Company will fund/arrange for training on all matters which are common to the whole Board

8. Performance Appraisal / Evaluation Process

As a member of the Board, your performance as well as the performance of the entire Board and its Committees shall be evaluated annually. Evaluation of each director shall be done by all the other directors. The criteria for evaluation shall be determined by the Nominations Committee and disclosed in the Company's Annual Report. However, the actual evaluation process shall remain confidential and shall be a constructive mechanism to improve the effectiveness of the Board / Committee. An indicative list of factors that may be evaluated as part of this exercise is:

- Participation and contribution by a director,
- Commitment (including guidance provided to senior management outside of Board /
- Committee meetings),
- Effective deployment of knowledge and expertise,
- Effective management of relationship with stakeholders,
- Integrity and maintenance of confidentiality,
- Independence of behaviour and judgment, and
- Impact and influence.

9. Disclosures, other directorships and business interests

During the Term, you agree to promptly notify the Company of any change in your directorships, and provide such other disclosures and information as may be required under the applicable laws. You also agree that upon becoming aware of any potential conflict of interest with your position as Independent Director of the Company, you shall promptly disclose the same to the Chairman or the Company Secretary.

During your Term, you agree to promptly provide a declaration under Section 149(7) of the 2013 Act, upon any change in circumstances which may affect your status as an Independent Director

10. Change of personal details

During the Term, you shall promptly intimate the Company Secretary and the Registrar of Companies in the prescribed manner, of any change in address or other contact and personal details provided to the Company.

11. Termination

Your directorship on the Board of the Company shall terminate or cease in accordance with law. Apart from the grounds of termination as specified in the 2013 Act, your directorship may be terminated for violation of any provision of the Company's Code of Conduct as applicable to the Directors. You may resign from the directorship of the Company by giving a notice in writing to the Company stating the reasons for resignation. The resignation shall take effect from the date on which the notice is received by the Company or the date, if any, specified by you in the notice, whichever is later. If at any stage during the Term, there is a change that may affect your status as an Independent Director as envisaged in Section 149(6) of the 2013 Act or, if applicable, you fail to meet the criteria for "independence" under the provisions of Clause 49 of the Listing Agreement, you agree to promptly submit your resignation to the Company with effect from the date of such change.

12. Cooperation

'In the event of any claim or litigation against the Company, based upon any alleged conduct, act or omission on your part during your Term, you agree to render all reasonable assistance and cooperation to the Company and provide such information and documents as are necessary and reasonably requested by the Company or its counsel.

13. Miscellaneous

This letter represents the entire understanding, and constitutes the whole agreement, in relation to your appointment and supersedes any previous agreement between yourself and the Company with respect thereto and, without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, excludes any warranty, condition or other undertaking implied at law or by custom.

- No waiver or modification of this letter shall be valid unless made in writing and signed by you and the Company.
- As per Clause 49 of the Listing Agreement, if applicable, this letter along with your detailed profile shall be disclosed on the website of the Company and the relevant stock exchange.
