OVERHIRING, LOWER ATTRITION WEIGH ON TALENT HUNT

Hiring pause at law firms amid signs of slowdown

INDIAN LAW FIRMS are going easy on hirings this year, with most firms anticipating a slowdown, especially in the M&A, private equity and venture capital space. This is in stark contrast to last year when top law firms had recruited hundreds of lawyers as business recovered in the aftermath of the pandemic.

"The past year has been good but we may see a slowdown in the coming year. Firms will be more calibrated, more measured in how they grow and how they want to build their businesses," said Suneeeth Katarki, founding partner, IndusLaw.

The international markets are witnessing a slowdown, and this may have an impact on the number of deals and investments flowing into India, added Shweta Shroff Chopra, partner, Shardul Amarchand Mangaldas & Co (SAM).

"The Indian economic growth forecast, however, makes us hopeful that work will continue to flow towards the bigger, quality-conscious firms which provide legal services across sectors. Top quality talent has always been valued and welcomed by SAM," said Chopra, who sees a gradual return of dual qualified lawyers back to the Indian shores.

The current demand for active talent from the Indian law firms is one-fourth of the active demand registered last year, according to Xpheno, a specialist staffing company. With active openings just under 450 (against over 2,000

last year) and attrition slowing down across the cohort, talent action (which takes into account replacement as well as expansion hiring) is set to remain low, it said.

"Top law firms had seen headcount growth of as high as 22-42% over the last two years. All sectors that hoarded talent and overhired during the buoyancy have had to resize and pause hiring. The law firms seem to be going through a similar phase of moderation in hiring plans and talent action," said Prasadh MS, head - Workforce Research, Xpheno.

Hiring from campuses, which could contribute up to a third of the overall recruitment annually, has been subdued as well. Experts attribute this to lower attrition levels seen in the past year, unlike the churn seen immediately after the pandemic.

Infrastructure, taxation & GST, patent & IPR, commercial laws, dispute resolution, data

privacy and cybersecurity are some areas that are likely to see an uptick in hiring this year.

"There's a huge amount of work happening in roads, rails, metros, ports and airports. Similarly, there is a push in the direction of green and hydrogen energy. Hiring in these areas could be commensurately higher," said Katarki.

Cyril Shroff, managing partner at Cyril Amarchand Mangaldas (CAM) said that the firm does not take a short-term view of the current environment and remains invested in its talent-first strategy.

"We have not witnessed any real slowdown. The focus is on our corporate, financing and disputes practices. Specifically, financial services, infrastructure, IT and gaming are likely to witness an uptick in hiring efforts," he said, without divulging specific numbers.

SAM's Chopra anticipates that practice areas such as corporate, projects, disputes

and capital markets will continue to be busy, and grow. With upcoming changes in laws, areas of data privacy, cybersecurity, white collar crime and competition law are also likely to gain attention and see a spurt in hiring, she said.

"As a firm, we have been hiring marginally more than previous years for our allied services (non-legal professionals), as these functions have grown to support the rapid growth of the legal practices. We have also introduced new functions such as risk, audit and compliance, digital and practice management to make our management structure and processes at par with the best-in-class," said Amar Sinhi, executive director (human resources) at Khaitan & Co.

Law firms believe it is too early to gauge the impact of the Bar Council of India's diktat to allow foreign law firms to practice in India on the basis of reciprocity.

IndusLaw's Katarki feels that foreign law firms will take some time to assess and figure out their exact path to come into India and it is unlikely that anyone will rush to establish large offices here. Accordingly, there would be no impact on hirings, especially at the fresher level, he said.

CAM's Shroff believes that with liberalisation there may be a need for more collaboration in the industry going forward. The increasingly competitive landscape is bound to lead to a dash for the right talent, he said: "We welcome the opportunity to collaborate with world class talent."

Goafest kicks off today

INDIA'S MOST HIGH-PROFILE advertising festival, Goafest 2023, will begin at the Grand Hyatt in Bambolim, Goa on Wednesday. Co-hosted by The Advertising Agencies Association of India (AAAI) and The Advertising Club (TAC), the 16th edition of the three-day event will see thousands of advertising and marketing professionals in attendance, and will have 60 global and Indian speakers & performers across 20 knowledge seminars and 11 master-classes.

The high point of the festival will be the announcement of the ABBY Awards, which honours creative excellence in advertising across various categories. The 54th edition of the awards have received 2,282 entries in creative compared to 2,007 last year; in media it has received 5 entries more than last year. Overall, there are 3,301 entries from 181 creative companies and 63 media agencies (last year there were 142 creative and 54 media agencies participating).

The jury includes Russell Barrett, chief creative experience officer (CCO), TBWA; Mandie van der Merwe, CCO, Dentsu (based in Sydney); P G Aditiya, co-founder and CCO, Talented and Guneet Monga, founder, Sikhya Entertainment, among others. Out of 21 jury chairs, seven are women.

This is also the second year ABBY has partnered with the world's most prestigious award show, The One Show. Ajay Kakar, managing committee member, The Advertising Club & co-chair,

The ABBYs Award Governing Council, said, "By associating with The One Show, we have their processes, systems and their judging filters, we have what the world expects when they directly go to One Show."

TAC has also announced the young maverick ABBY Award to recognise disruptive ideas and talent for participants under the age of 30 years. It will honour work done across categories like broadcasting, design, public relations, technology, cinema, radio, video craft, out-of-home, print and much more. It has also introduced new sub-categories in digital technology, mobile, design, and audio technology.

The three-day symposium's theme is 'The Future of Creativity is Here'. Mohit Joshi, CEO, Havas Media Group India, & Goafest 2023 co-chair, says burning issues like generative AI and its

role in creativity and other domains of communication will be taken up for discussion. "The whole objective is to see how these technologies are going to shape the future. In fact, the creatives that you see for this year's event have been generated by AI," he adds.

Several prominent agencies including Mullen Lintas (with 15 entries), Wunderman Thompson (with 57 entries) and McCann Worldgroup (with 16 entries) will be returning to the festival this year. Meta project to preserve language diversity

IN AN EFFORT to preserve the rich diversity of languages worldwide, Meta on Tuesday said it is publicly sharing its models and code related to the Massively Multilingual Speech (MMS) project. The social media giant believes that equipping machines with the ability to recognise and pro-



duce speech will greatly enhance accessibility to information, particularly for individuals who rely solely on voice

for accessing data.

Meta stated that developing high-quality machine learning models for speech-related tasks necessitates vast amounts of labelled data, including thousands of hours of audio recordings along with transcriptions. However, the challenge lies in the fact that such data is often non-existent for most languages.

Currently, existing speech recognition models cover only a fraction of the world's over 7,000 known languages, leaving approximately half of them in danger of disappearing within our lifetime, the company said in a blog.

To address these challenges, Meta's MMS project combines its self-supervised learning techniques, wav2vec 2.0, and a new dataset comprising labelled data for over 1,100 languages, along with unlabelled data for nearly 4,000 languages. This approach allows Meta to overcome data scarcity, even for languages with a small

number of speakers, such as the Tatuayo language. The results demonstrate that the MMS models outperform existing models and provide coverage for ten times as many languages.

Additionally, Meta has developed text-to-speech systems for over 1,100 languages, surpassing the limitations of current models trained on speech corpora from a single speaker. Although the MMS dataset contains relatively few different speakers for many languages, this limitation proved advantageous for building text-to-speech systems that produce high-quality speech.

While Meta acknowledges that their AI models are not flawless, as there is a risk of mistranscribing certain words or phrases, the company emphasises the importance of collaboration within the AI community for responsible development.

Trent sets up 50:50 JV with Singapore's MAS Amity

TATA GROUP'S TRENT on Tuesday incorporated a new company Trent MAS Fashion as a 50:50 joint venture with Singapore-based MAS Amity, it said in an exchange filing.

The new entity will focus on the business of designing, developing and manufacturing intimate apparel and other related products in India.

Both the companies, Trent and MAS Amity, have subscribed equally to 5 lakh equity shares of the new entity at a face value of ₹10 each, amounting to a total of ₹50 lakh, Trent said in the exchange filing.

The joint venture company has an authorised share capital of Rs 1 crore, which is divided into 10 lakh equity shares of the company, with each share having a value of Re 1.

The collaboration between Trent and MAS is aimed at deepening Trent's ability to offer fully owned brands at its retail stores, along with helping MAS to expand its international presence.

UPSC results: Record number of women selected this year

THE UNION PUBLIC Service Commission (UPSC) made history on Tuesday by selecting the highest number of women ever for the Indian civil services.

Over one-third of the 933 candidates (320) recommended for appointment are women. This is significant considering that just two decades ago, women accounted for just 20% of the selected candidates (see box).

Moreover, the top four ranks this year have been claimed by women. This is the second consecutive year that women candidates have secured the top three positions.

Ishita Kishore, a Delhi University (DU) student from Gautam Buddha Nagar, topped the examination in her third attempt with political science and international relations as her optional subjects. She graduated with an Economics (Honours) degree from Shri Ram College of Commerce at DU.

While the all-India second position holder, Garima Lohia

from Buxar in Bihar, is also a DU graduate with a commerce degree from Kiroirimal College, Uma Harathi N from Telangana, who holds a B.Tech degree from IIT Hyderabad, came third. Smriti Mishra, a BSc graduate from Miranda House College, secured the fourth rank.

Congratulating the rank holders, Union minister Jitendra Singh tweeted, "Women power at its best! Congratulations Ishita Kishore, Garima Lohia, and Uma Harithi N, the first three toppers in #UPSC #CivilServicesExamination 2022 Final. A day of celebration also for all the others who have made it. #DoPT."

Traditionally a male bastion, the civil services have witnessed a gradual increase in women's repre-

sentation over the past 20 years. However, the surge in their absolute numbers and share of the total pie this year is the most remarkable increase to date.

Last year, 685 candidates were recommended for appointment, of which 508 were men and 177 were women. This year, about 320 of the 933 selected candidates are women. Women's representation witnessed a jump of almost 9 percentage points compared to last year.

In the Civil Services (Main) Exam 2019 results, 922 candidates, a number comparable to this year's results, were recommended for appointment. Even then, women comprised 24% of the total pool, as opposed to 34% this year.
